LONG-DISTANCE BAY RACE

- When:** Saturday, July 19, 2003. The warning gun will be 0925 hours on Saturday, July 19, 2003 from the Golden Gate Yacht Club Race Deck.
- Where:** The race starts at the Golden Gate Yacht Club to Mark 16 at Crissy Field; then to Mark 17, Harding Rock; to the South Bay; to the North Bay, and back to the Golden Gate Yacht Club. Classic Course 67 miles for multi-hulls, sport boats, ultra-lights, PHRF, One Design and Double-Handed 159 and below. Short course 41 miles for PHRF, One Design and Double-Handed 160 and above.
- Eligibility:** Open to those yachts whose owners, or bona fide charterers, are members of the Yacht Racing Association (YRA) of San Francisco Bay or other yacht racing association that meets or exceeds the YRA minimum equipment requirements.
- Ratings:** PHRF division yachts and BAMA yachts shall enclose a copy of a current rating certificate. Contact YRA (415-771-9500) for certificate information.
- One Design Eligibility:** Yachts racing in a one-design class shall meet all of the requirements of their class association. All yachts in a one-design class shall receive the same handicap rating. A minimum of four registered one-design yachts is required for one-design eligibility.
- Double-Handed Eligibility:** A minimum of four registered double-handed yachts is required for double-handed eligibility.
- Deadline:** The entry form and copy of your rating certificate must be filed with the Race Committee by 8:00 p.m. on July 14, 2003. An entry fee of \$40.00, payable to Island Yacht Club, must be included with the entry form. Late registrations may be accepted after July 14th with a \$5.00 late fee.
