SILVER EAGLE
LONG-DISTANCE BAY RACE**

WHEN:	Saturday and Sunday, July 20 and 21, 2002. The warning gun will be 0925 hours on Saturday, July 20, 2002 from the Golden Gate Yacht Club Race Deck.
WHERE:	The race starts at the Golden Gate Yacht Club to Mark 16 at Crissy Field; then to Mark 17, Harding Rock; to the South Bay; to the North Bay, and back to the Golden Gate Yacht Club. Classic Course 67 miles for multihulls, sportboats, ultralights, PHRF, One Design and Double Handed 159 and below. Short course 41 miles for PHRF, One Design and Double Handed 160 and above.
ELIGIBILITY:	Open to those yachts whose owners, or bona fide charterers, are members of the Yacht Racing Association (YRA) of San Francisco Bay or other yacht racing association that meets or exceeds the YRA minimum equipment requirements.
RATINGS:	PHRF division yachts and BAMA yachts shall enclose a copy of a current rating certificate. Contact YRA at (415) 771-9500 for certificate information. Divisions will be assigned and sent with sailing instructions.
ONE DESIGN ELIGIBILITY:	Yachts racing in a One Design class shall meet all of the requirements of their class association. All yachts in an ODCA class shall receive the same handicap rating and will be assigned to a PHRF division by the committee. A minimum of five registered One Design yachts is required for One Design eligibility.
DOUBLE HANDED ELIGIBILITY:	A minimum of five registered Double-Handed yachts is required for Double Handed eligibility.
DEADLINE:	The entry form and a copy of your rating certificate must be filed with the Race Committee by 8:00pm on July 12, 2002. An entry fee of \$40.00 (\$35.00 for US Sailing members), payable to Island Yacht Club, must be included with the entry form. Late registrations may be accepted after July 12, 2000 with a \$5.00 late fee.
RACE INSTRUCTIONS AND DIVISIONS:	Race instructions and divisions will be available after July 14, 2002 at the IYC clubhouse, online at www.iyc.org , or by telephone request to Diane Duey McClure.
