



Island Yacht Club Presents the 2005
Commodore's Cup
"Two Mark Fiasco"
Saturday, November 19, 2005

This race will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 (RRS) and the Standard Sailing Instructions of the YRA of San Francisco Bay and these sailing instructions.

Entries: Open to any member of the Island Yacht club. Members may charter a boat, but it must be skippered by an IYC member. There is no entry fee or entry form. This is a PHRF handicap race. A PHRF number will be assigned by race chairs if you do not have one.

Start: Between 1200 and 1215 hours. Engines must be turned off 5 minutes before a boat starts. The latest a boat may motor is 1210 hours. Boats will take their own start and finish time. Times may be called to 510-521-2980 or reported in person at IYC. Time limit 1700 hours.

Awards: Prizes and snacks at IYC after the race. The Commodore's Perpetual Trophy will be presented at the Change of Watch Dinner on December 3, 2005.

Course: Start, Mark 1 and Mark 2 (Marks 1 and 2 may taken in either order, and to either side), Finish. 11.5 nm scored time on distance.

Start/Finish: Between Fl g 5s 30ft 10M (5) Horn (concrete marker with blue light at entrance of estuary) AND Red Fl R 6s 15ft 4M (6) at entrance of estuary.

Mark 1 – YRA 8
R "4" Fl 4s Horn 1 nm East of Point Blunt

Mark 2 – NAS 2
R "2" Fl R 4s NAS

Protests: Strongly discouraged and will be arbitrated at IYC after the race.

Communications: Radio channel 68. Racers are encouraged to keep radios turned to channel 68. IYC Clubhouse will monitor Channel 68.
